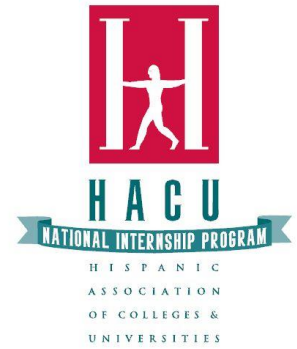

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Field measurement skills (tree and plant allometry), map reading and field navigation, simple GPS. Ability to work unsupervised. Juvenile tree data collection and evaluation; Read background materials; visit research sites on Fort Valley Experimental Forest; Measure seedling populations and over story canopy characteristics; Experimental design; Measure over story tree species, size, density; sapling and seedling species and density long-term uneven-aged plots on the Fort Valley Experimental Forest.
