POSITION TITLE: Foreign Service Intern - USDA

INTERNSHIP LOCATION: Flagstaff, AZ

DESIRED MAJORS: Biochemistry, Biology, Botany/Plant Biology

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Biological or chemical laboratory work, hiking, outdoor work, interest in plants, attention to detail, ability to work independently, greenhouse experience.

Interns will gain knowledge and skills related to soil analyses and plant responses in burned forests. Position will provide training in working safely in an analytical laboratory, maintaining quality control in analytical processes, working safely in the field, characterizing plant communities in burned areas, and monitoring experiments in greenhouses. The position will provide skills in soil sample preparation, measuring soil water content, texture, and pH, using a GPS unit to record spatial locations, and recording and summarizing data.
